

A high-level roundtable on "AI in Entrepreneurship Education", bringing together policy, business, and education leaders to discuss how AI is transforming the way we prepare young people for the future of work.

Mario Nava, Director General at the European Commission (DG EMPL), emphasized that AI is now a core element of lifelong learning and noted that over 60% of Europe's workforce will need additional training to adapt to its impact.

Student teams SeedSAP and PulsePal showcased how digital and AI skills can fuel innovation with real societal impact.







## **EDUCATORS SESSION**

### EDUCATORS' LEADING ENTREPRENEURIAL CHANGE







A dedicated Educator's Session brought together teachers, policymakers, and innovation leaders to explore how entrepreneurial learning can equip students for a fast-changing world. Discussions ranged from integrating AI and project management into classrooms to strengthening links between education and innovation.

The session was moderated by Diana Filip, Deputy CEO at JA Europe, with contributions from Kari Kivinen (EUIPO) and Dr. Ashley Dalton Forsyth (PMIEF).

### **#PULSEZ CONSORTIUM MEETING**

The PulseZ consortium gathered for its second in-person meeting, bringing together representatives from eight partner organisations to advance the development of the PulseZ platform, a hub for new media content creators and journalists across Europe.

Eight young journalists used PulseZ to kick-start their journey in event documentation, content creation, and live reporting. The consortium partners also showcased the platform at the PulseZ stand, engaging with more than 600 participants and expanding its outreach.











## GET IN THE RING BY UNKNOWN







The Unknown University of Applied Sciences and Unknown Group brought a unique energy to Athens with Get in the Ring, a competition where young innovators pitched bold solutions in a real boxing ring.

Two standout JA teams entered the spotlight: SeedSAP from JA Denmark and PulsePal from JA Albania. Both teams impressed with their vision and passion, but it was PulsePal who took home the title, recognized for their empathy-driven innovation and potential for societal impact.




#### **Hellenic Cosmos**


